Introduction of City Manager Noah Simon to the Board Members

Administer Oath of Office to newly appointed board member Garhett Gordon

Motion was made by Director Randy Keck, seconded by Director Spencer Perrry to approve the minutes from the AEDC meeting held on February 17, 2022 as presented.

OTHER BUSINESS

2. Discussion and action to consider approval of the proposed 2022-2023 FY Budget.

City Manager Noah Simon addressed the AEDC Board to discuss the proposed 2022-2023 FY Budget. This year there will be no transfer from the General Fund to the Water fund. In years past this was common practice. The utility rates have been increased this year and will be increased each year for the next few years. The General Fund property tax rate has increased by 3.5% for this year due to the construction of the new City Hall. We will be operating on a balanced budget with no defecit speinding. There are many projects for infrastructure in this budget. The main ones are repair of Bailey Ranch Road, Clear Fork Interceptor and the Safe Routes to School for sidewalks along Bailey Ranch Road. We come to the board to ask for approval of the FY 2022-2023 Budget that would include a transfer to General Fund of \$243,500 that willl help offset costs for shade structures at Bearcat Park, a GIS System for Community Development, a portion of the Safe Routes to School Sidewalk program and Parks upkeep and event expenditures.

Motion was made by Director Spencer Perry, seconded by Director Randy Keck to approve the Proposed FY 2022-2023 AEDC Budget as presented and discussed.

Motion carried 5-0
