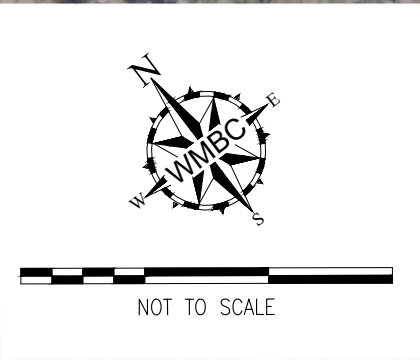


ON THIS TRAIL YOU MAY EXPERIENCE:

- NATURAL SURFACE - DIRT, MUD, GRAVEL, SHIFTING ROCK, SLIPPERY SURFACE, ETC.
- ROCKS, ROOTS, AND/OR DOWNED VEGETATION ON TRAIL.
- STEEP GRADES AND INCLINES MORE THAN 10%.
- WATER / STREAM CROSSINGS WITHOUT BRIDGES.
- BRIDGES AND/OR STRUCTURAL CROSSINGS.
- PHYSICALLY CHALLENGING OBSTACLES.
- BLUFFS OR DROP-OFFS NEXT TO TRAIL.
- RAISED OR PROTRUDING OBSTACLES.
- OCCASIONAL WATER OVER TRAIL.
- LOW-HANGING VEGETATION.
- WOOD OR STONE STEPS.
- NARROW PASSAGES.
- ROAD CROSSING.

TRAIL REMINDERS:

- DON'T RIDE, HIKE OR RUN MUDDY TRAILS.

- READ THE "RULES OF THE TRAIL."
- TRAIL AND BRIDGES FREEZE AT 32°.

- CARRY ENOUGH WATER.
- WATCH FOR SNAKES.
- STAY ON TRAIL.

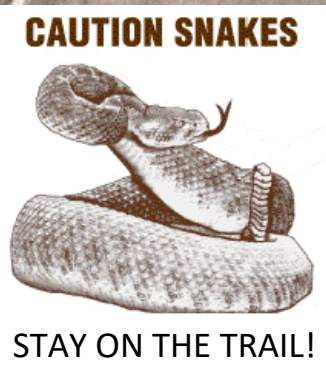
