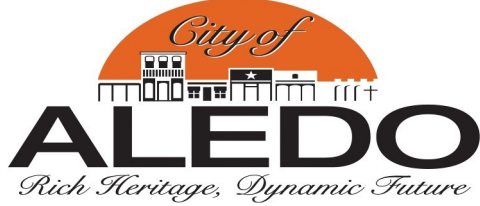


### SIDEWALK UPDATE

TXDOT approved two **sidewalk grants** for our City: one for construction of a sidewalk from Autumnwood (South FM5) to McAnally Intermediate; and, a second grant to extend the sidewalk along FM1187 in front of the Middle School and Vandagriff Elementary, and connect to the existing sidewalk Downtown. These projects will be completed this year.
