OUTDOOR WARNING SYSTEM

The City of Aledo has been awarded a FEMA Grant for two Outdoor Warning Sirens to enhance the safety of our residents. One will be installed at the new Fire Station #34 on Bailey Ranch Road, and one on the South side of the City.

Outdoor Warning Siren(s) shall be activated under the following criteria:

- Tornado Warning issued by NWS, naming specific community in which the siren is located.
- Tornado or Funnel cloud observed by public safety personnel with imminent threat to the specific community in which the siren is located.
- Request of activation by the Fire Chief or the Parker County Emergency Management Coordinator **ONLY**.
- Severe Thunderstorm Warning issued by NWS for the specific community in which the siren is located, **AND** forecasted or verified conditions of 70 mph winds or greater, or half-dollar size (1.25") hail or greater.
