DID YOU KNOW? City Permits are required for many home repairs, improvements, and construction projects. To avoid a possible citation, contact City Hall or check the City's website for a list of permits before you begin your project.



OUTDOOR WARNING SYSTEM

SPRING STORMS can be very dangerous, but the City of Aledo is looking out for you. We have two Outdoor Warning Sirens to enhance the safety of our residents; One is at ESD1Fire Station #34 on Bailey Ranch Road, and the other is at Aledo Middle School.

Outdoor Warning Siren(s) shall be activated under the following criteria:

- Tornado Warning issued by NWS, naming specific community in which the siren is located.
- b. Tornado or Funnel cloud observed by public safety personnel with imminent threat to the specific community in which the siren is located.
- c. Request of activation by the Fire Chief or the Parker County Emergency Management Coordinator **ONLY**.
- Severe Thunderstorm Warning issued by NWS for the specific community in which the siren is located, <u>AND</u> forecasted or verified conditions of 70 mph winds

DO YOU NEED TO FLUSH YOUR WATER HEATER?

The idea of flushing the water heater is foreign to many homeowners, but performing simple, routine maintenance on your water heater can make it last longer, and keep minor repairs from becoming major expenses.

Start by checking all pipe connections each month for leaks. On gas models, make sure the vent pipe is properly installed and there are no obstructions. Each year, open the pressure relief valve on top of the tank for a few seconds and see that hot water comes out

of the overflow pipe. Finally, periodically drain a bucket of water from the faucet at the bottom of the water heater to remove sediment buildup.

Always use extreme caution when dealing with appliances, especially those involving gas and electric—and potentially scalding water. If you are ever in doubt, call in a professional to assist. You may find a list of Aledo businesses under the "Shop Local" tab of our website.
