FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018 BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

In September 2017, City Council approved the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget with the new budget to be implemented on October 1, 2017. The approved Budget for all City Funds (General Fund, Water/Wastewater, Debt Fund and Economic Development Fund) is \$6,832,062. The current tax rate (\$0.3850) will remain the same. Also, the total appraised value of all properties is \$337,340,817, an increase of \$62,172,617 from last year due to new construction. This budget continues to be conservative and cost-effective because we watch our expenditures very closely with savings in mind for you, our taxpayers. Also, an updated five (5) year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) outlines estimated costs for vehicles, equipment, personnel, facilities, and programs. The CIP is a blueprint to help guide City planning efforts and outline funding options and time frames for major capital expenses as the City grows.

The FY 2017-2018 Budget has one new Public Works position. The City has 16 full-time and 4 part-time positions to effectively carry out the budget plan.

Street Improvements and repairs will continue into the new fiscal year through our street program. In this new budget year, Cherry, James, and Jearl Streets will be repaired. The City was awarded grant funding to construct a sidewalk along FM 5 from Autumnwood to the McAnally Intermediate School, and this project is scheduled to be completed in 2017. The City also received a second sidewalk grant award to continue the sidewalk along FM5 and FM1187 to connect the McAnally Intermediate School with the Middle School and Vandagriff Elementary School and connect to the existing sidewalk Downtown. This sidewalk project will be completed in 2017. The City of Aledo is 1 of 9 cities that has been selected for a third grant that will fund an additional sidewalk project from City Hall west on Old Annetta Road.

The Library appropriation will increase from \$25,000 to \$30,000 due to their growing needs. The City will add a parking lot and restroom facility in the Aledo Commons located across the street east of City Hall.
