Brad Lonberger, Project Manager Kimley-Horn addressed the Commission stating the "Downtown Master Plan" is derived from previous planning work and community engagement. This plan brings together the Pine Street District, Historic District, Civil Center District and South Commercial District. These districts create a diverse Downtown that is separate from other communities. Implementation strategy was also discussed.

Commission members discussed the plan identifying low impact development, sustainability and green space as important aspects for the plan.

- 2) Public Hearing to consider amending the City of Aledo Zoning Ordinance to establish criteria for Food Truck Parks and to classify Food Truck Parks as a permitted land use with the City Council's discretionary approval of a Specific Use Permit in the following zoning districts of the city:
 - a. A-A Agricultural District
 - b. C-1 Commercial District Office, Light Retail, and Neighborhood Services
 - c. C-2 Commercial District General
 - d. C-3 Commercial District Heavy
 - e. M-1 Manufacturing/Industrial District Light
 - f. M-2 Manufacturing/Industrial District Heavy
 - g. DB Downtown Business District

Betty Chew spoke regarding the proposed "Food Truck Park" ordinance. The ordinance classifies the use in the identified districts with discretionary approval of a Special Use Permit.

Mike Sugg, 129 Robert Street, Aledo Texas addressed the Commission, stating he owns and operates a food truck at various locations in the Fort Worth area. He stated common problems are traffic and parking. He would like to have a location to operate in Aledo.
