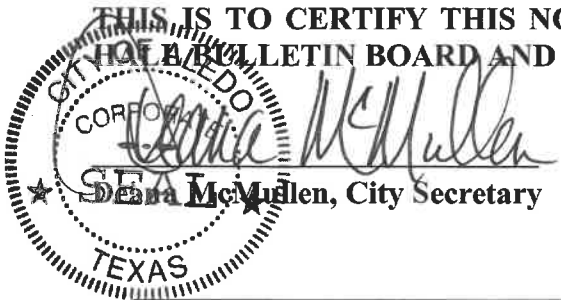
**COUNCIL AND STAFF COMMENTS**
